FAQ

- **What is the ACE Senior Scholarship?**
 - The ACE Senior Scholarship is fundraised and organized locally by the ACE Mentor Program of Oregon. Each year, the ACE Mentor Program awards scholarships to seniors who are committed to pursuing design-build careers through college or apprenticeship training programs. Recipients will be awarded at the Finals.
- **What is the ACE National Summer Camp?**
 - The ACE National Summer Camp is arranged by the College of Architecture and Planning for all of the 77 ACE affiliates to send campers to participate in a weeklong overnight summer camp. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a design build project with other students, experience living on a campus, and more. ACE Oregon uses a scholarship to award the cost of travel to camp and to select their campers. Recipients will be awarded at the Finals.
- **What is the ACE Summer Workplace Experience (SWE)?**
 - The Summer Workplace Experience (SWE) is a paid program for students that will complete one year of ACE by Summer 2024. The SWE is an opportunity for students to shadow A/E/C professionals and continue the ACE mentorship experience in greater depth. Firms will host students for 80 hours from July 8-August 30, 2024. Students will receive a stipend of \$1,600 (\$20/hr) for participating. Participants are selected through the application process and are notified of their pairing with host firms by Mid-May.
- **Where can I apply to different ACE opportunities?**
 - All ACE applications will be posted in the [ACE Database](#), used during registration for the program.
- **How can I submit different documents?**
 - Documents should be uploaded in PDF format with the applicant's first and last name in the title of the file.
- **How can I get a mentor evaluation or educator recommendation?**
 - Students are responsible for asking mentors and educators for evaluations and letters of recommendation. It is recommended to give folks plenty of time to complete recommendations. Mentors and Educators can send documents to ace@portlandworkforcealliance.org with the student name in the subject line by April 12th.
